


Keep Kentucky's Highways Beautiful

- Any permanently established business, association, community or public organization, or government entity can adopt a stretch of highway.
- Participants must be at least 13 years of age. Anyone under age 18 must be supervised by an adult.
- Participation in the Adopt-a-Highway program is on a strictly volunteer basis. KYTC does not compensate groups or individual participants.

- Minimum of two miles for a period of two years.
- May renew the contract at the end of the two years.
- Minimum of four cleanups a year, three of which are scheduled by KYTC.
- Cleanup dates:
 - Spring Clean: March 19 25, 2018
 - Summer Scrub: June 18 24, 2018
 - Fall Sweep: October 8-14, 2018
- Cleanups involve both sides of the road within the adopted section.

- •KYTC provides safety vests, trash bags, and warning signs.
- •Filled bags will be collected by KYTC Maintenance Crews if requested.
- Must review roadside safety information will all participants prior to each cleanup.
- •One sign will be installed on the adopted roadway with the name of the organization or group.
- Groups are asked to complete a survey after each cleanup.
