Scholarship Name: Kentucky Master Farm Homemakers Guild

Who Can Apply:

- Currently active Kentucky Master Farm Homemakers (KMFH) Guild member
- ✓ Spouse of currently active KMFH member
- ✓ Immediate family member (descendent) of a current or formerly active KMFH member (includes step-children, but <u>does not</u> include nieces and nephews, brothers or sisters)

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Full-time student status
- ✓ Evidence of a "B" or above grade point average (minimum of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale)
- ✓ Demonstration of financial need (written explanation requested on application)
- ✓ Evidence of leadership skills and participation in activities
- Must be pursuing a degree, certificate or course of study at a Kentucky accredited college/university
- ✓ All degree programs are eligible, but preference will be given to students majoring in agriculture or family and consumer sciences programs
